2006 Key Organizational Outcomes

What is the Mentoring Partnership of Minnesota?

The Mentoring Partnership of Minnesota (MPM) strengthens and expands mentoring activities all across the state in three vital ways: 1) Through promotional programs, volunteer recruitment campaigns, and referral services, MPM makes it possible for more at-risk kids to benefit from a mentoring relationship. 2) Through training programs, MPM improves the quality of the mentoring experience for both the youth mentee and the adult mentor. 3) Through research on mentoring needs and mentoring program capacity, as well as active community organizing on public policy initiatives, MPM increases public and private investment in mentoring.

Current Programs and Activities

(1) Mentor Recruitment -*Building Awareness*: Our public service campaigns connect thousands of caring adult mentors with young people in need. *Respond to Inquiries*: Each year we respond to over 30,000 inquiries for referrals to mentoring programs through our phone center and our website. *Direct Recruitment*: To date we have recruited over 50,000 volunteer mentors to support more than 170,000 kids in Minnesota. This represents an 88% increase since 2002.

(2) Minnesota Business Partnership Connections Program -Minnesota Business Partnership, an association representing 100 of the largest companies in Minnesota, has selected MPM to operate the MBP *Connections* program, an exciting initiative that builds corporate commitment for youth mentoring.

(3) Mentor Training Institute -Since 1995 MPM has been the provider of choice for dozens of resources to regional mentoring programs. Through MPM's Training Institute, MPM has trained more than 12,000 mentors and supported more than 300 mentor programs with training and technical assistance.

(4) Metro Mentor Network and Minnesota Mentor Network -The Mentoring Partnership operates the Metro Mentor Network to bring together program professionals from over 400 mentor programs for regular meetings that focus on issues that are relevant to mentor program staff.

(5) Assessment of Mentoring Needs, Program Effectiveness, and Outcomes in Children -During 2006 MPM, in cooperation with the University of Minnesota, completed the first phase of research and analysis in a social return on investment evaluation of mentoring programs. Mentoring programs across the state are using the results of this study to engage more public policy, community, and corporate leaders in the mentor movement.

(6) Public Policy -MPM works with a variety of stakeholders to craft public policy and educate policy makers about mentoring.

(7) Executive Youth Board (EYB) -MPM facilitates a youth leadership board comprised of young people participating in mentoring programs. EYB members serve leaders and champions for mentoring across Minnesota.
